On 22.12.2016, at the University of the East Sarajevo, project management team organized second dissemination seminar with the main aim to deliver to participants information about Charter and Code and Excellence in Research practice, information about major grants in research and possible approaches in research, different methodologies used in obligatory used by researchers, preparation of project proposals, and about importance of the opening of the University towards work-field and community. 60 participants took part on the seminar and vast majority were doctoral candidates and researchers, but also representatives of the Brčko District government, Employment Bureau, and representatives of successful companies. At the beginning Prof Srdjan Lalic, as a Dean of Faculty of Economics of Brčko, and as a host, gave few welcome words. Training started with the presentation about importance of Charter and code and HR excellence label to one University. Prof Bokonjic described in details code of good practice, about 40 principles importance for development of the researcher career and why is this important to one University. We spoke about Euraxess network and advantages and problems for researchers in Europe and in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Prof Bokonjic described also Re@WBC project and emphasize importance of this project for development of UES.

After prof Bokonjic, Mr Marković gave presentation in details about our application for Charter and code which was submitted recently by our University to EU Commission. He clearly described all performed steps and what we have to fulfill if get positive answer by EU Commission.

Next speaker was prof Berjan who spoke to young researchers what methodologies and procedures are important for young researchers. He also spoke about publications, why to prepare good oral and poster presentation and what are necessary precondition to publish article in the international journal.

After him Prof Lalic spoke about transformation of the faculties and universities toward enterprises and role of entrepreneurship on the University. He presented examples of good practice in this area.

Mr. Damir Bulčević, main coordinator in Brčko District Government and perennial Head of Department for Industry, informed participants about the possibilities of starting own business and support which is given by the Brčko District Government in this field.

After mr. Bulčević, mr. Vlado Jeftić, Director of the Employment Bureau of Brčko District gave few word. Representatives of successful companies gave examples of good practices in starting own business.

The last presentation was held by Mr Nenad Marković, who also held a practical workshop on preparation of project proposals for international projects.

After the last presentation we organized big discussion and all presenters actively participated in this last session.

The whole event was organized successfully, participants evaluated event as good one and major recommendation was that we continue with similar events in the future.
