<p>At October 05th, Re@WBC project team of the University of East Sarajevo take place at The eighth international agricultural symposium AGROSYM 2017 at Termag hotel, Jahorina, Republic of Srpska, BiH, with a presentation of project results and importance of project activities for the academic community in BiH, especially in achieving the HR logo. AGROSYM 2017 was organized by the Faculty of Agriculture of the University of East Sarajevo, the Faculty of Agriculture at the University of Belgrade and the Agronomy Mediterranean Institute from Bari. More than 1300 participants (scientists and researchers, private and public sector representatives, NGO representatives) from 85 countries of the world have been registered for this year's "AGROSYM", and about 1300 abstracts and over 600 complete papers have been received. The Ministry of Science and Technology of the Republic of Srpska categorized 'AGROSYM' as a meeting of special importance, and that this is an opportunity for domestic researchers to get to know the latest achievements from worldwide.
