Short description:	<p>This one-day seminar was organized by representatives of the University of Vlora "Ismail Qemali" in order to inform participants (PhD students, prospective PhD students) about the role and significance of C&C and HRS4R and the opportunities HEIs can have if they obtain the "HR Excellence in Research" label. The seminar was organized into two sessions, a morning session which took place in Building A, Faculty of Economics and an afternoon session, which took place in Building B, Faculty of Humanities. 59 participants attended the first session and 23 attended the second session. Each session of the seminar covered different topics like the possibilities offered by the Euraxess services, Euraxess Albania, the importance of mobility for young researchers, Charter and Code for researchers, challenges facing researchers today in Albania and worldwide, HRS4R and the importance of implementing C&C principles. The seminar was conceived in an interactive form following a Q&A format. The speakers in this seminar were Assoc. prof. Elenica Pjero (Beqiraj) and Assoc. prof. Armela Panajoti.</p>
