Within activity 3.3. Young researchers trained on research methodology the Re@WBC project team from the University of Nis has organized four trainings in total. The first one was organized at the Faculty of Science and Mathematics, University of Nis on 24 May, 2017 and 68 Phd students, researchers and professors participated in it. The speaker was dr Ivan Palic, associate professor at this faculty. The second training was organized at the Faculty of Techonology, University of Nis on 01 June, 2017. The total number of participants was 15, mostly PhD students and teaching assistants. On 05, June, 2017, a training was organized at the Faculty of Pedagogy, University of Nis which is located in Vranje. The trainer was dr Sasa Nikolic, professor from the Faculty of Electronic, University of Nis and there were 23 participants.

The prevailing impression after the trainings was an overall satisfaction among the participants, who had plenty to ask during and afterwards which led to a lively and a very diverse and comprehensive discussion that followed the official sessions, all of which attests to their success even more given that this kind of trainings had never been organized before at the University of Nis. Since, as part of the initiative launched by the RE@WBC project team, the book of regulations of the Career development Centre has been changed in so much that mandatory trainings have been introduced for young researchers, it is our intention to,
