He started his presentation by giving the brief information about the Re@WBC project, and its main goals, and then continued with the training for Charter &amp; Code. The workshop included all necessary information – from the history part of introducing these two documents, to its main content and the way to implement HRS4R and obtain the HR Excellence in Research award. It was explained in detail what does it mean for institutions and for their researchers to respect these principles and to have HR award. Later on, in conversation with the attendees, Euraxess portal was presented, and the part which refers to the Charter &amp; Code and HRS4R, but as well the part for “Jobs”. Since the call for MSCA Individual Fellowships is opened at this time, our attendees also received information about how to search for the hosting institutions at the Euraxess portal.</p>
